Our beliefs

Everyone has the right to develop their full potential and to live free of poverty in a more just and secure world. We believe that the measures and adequate political will, the world is possible.

People have a right to life and security, to have a sustainable livelihood, to be heard and to have an identity and access to basic social services. We signed all the international agreements on human rights and the Universal Declaration of Human Rights of the United Nations.

When they are in poverty, people have little power and are denied the right to be heard. Poverty means very limited income and assets, lack of access to basic social services and opportunities, deep inequality, insecurity and little prospect of development.

Inequality, together with the action or lack of action, is the underlying cause of poverty. Also can be compounded by natural disasters, violence, oppression and environmental degradation, and perpetuated by institutions and certain economic activities.

Women and girls are the ones who suffer most from poverty. Defend their rights and needs is key if we want to eradicate it.

During this century we face unprecedented changes and challenges such as climate change, famine crisis in the prices of food, humanitarian crises, energy constraints, the proliferation of weapons, over-urbanization and the scarcity of natural resources. To address these challenges, we need greater cohesion and cooperation globally.

Governments are accountable to their citizens, as should all institutions, enterprises, organizations and groups in society, including ours.

INDEPENDENCE

Global Solidarity work in compliance with strict political and religious neutrality and impartiality. However, it can be taken to denounce the violations of human rights that witnesses, and those brought obstacles to the smooth development of its humanitarian mission.

NO DISCRIMINATION

Global Solidarity rejects, in its action, discrimination on grounds of race, sex, religion, nationality, political opinion or social class.

FREE AND DIRECT ACCESS TO VICTIMS

Global Solidarity bases its interventions on the requirement of free access to victims and direct control of its programs, ensuring the means to achieve it. Check that resources go directly to beneficiaries. In any case, the partners with which it works on the ground will be the direct beneficiaries of its programs.

PROFESSIONALISM

Global Solidarity based the design, implementation, management and evaluation of its programs in the professionalism and experience of its human resources in order to optimize the effectiveness and proper use of resources.
